We at The Sapphire Coast Resort and Casino would like to thank you for your recent visit to our hotel. While we strive to provide an accommodating atmosphere for our clientele, it is the customer's responsibility to cover any costs incurred from that atmosphere. We received your room payment for the standard two-night stay in our imperial suite, however upon further inspection of your room there were additional charges not reflected in your final total.
